Today is the eighth Sunday and last day of the octave of Easter, the Second Sunday of Easter, which now also bears the name of Divine Mercy Sunday. The readings and prayer texts of the day emphasize peace, reconciliation, and the new creation.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY:

“The Gospel is the revelation in Jesus Christ of God’s mercy to sinners.” The title Divine Mercy was given to this Sunday by Pope John Paul II in 200 when he canonized Sister Faustina Kowalska. In a homily he had prepared for the Second Sunday of Easter / Divine Mercy Sunday just before his death and that was presented posthumously, the Pope said,

“To humanity, which at times seems to be lost and dominated by the power of evil, selfishness, and fear, the risen Lord offers the gift of his love that pardons, reconciles, and opens the soul to hope. It is love that converts hearts and brings peace... How much the world needs to understand and accept Divine Mercy!”

We are called to act daily with a spirit of mercy toward our neighbors and our enemies, with prayers, words, and deeds.

FIRST READING: As the Holy Spirit filled the apostles with ever-deepening faith in the power of Jesus’ Resurrection, Jesus’ ministry of healing comes to life in them. As the crowds once flocked to Jesus to experience the power of God’s healing mercy, they now flock to the apostles, for their touch bestows a share in Christ’s healing power. As believers, we are enlivened by the Resurrection to be instruments of God’s grace and healing.

SECOND READING: Paul proclaims the intimate union shared between Christ and his body, the Church, by linking the Resurrection of believers to the Resurrection of Christ. He takes the doctrine of faith in the Resurrection of Jesus and claims that to deny the general Resurrection of the dead is, in fact, to deny Christ’s own. The Church rejoices for Christ has gathered us to himself and shares the fullness of his new life with us.

GOSPEL: For Jesus, those who are poor, hungry, sorrowful, and hated exemplify those who place their trust in God and so will be blessed. On the other hand, the rich, satisfied, jocular, and well respected in this age will one day experience affliction. We are blessed when we stand with Christ, who emptied himself and stood with us in our lowliness.

The Cornerstone Reunion will be on Friday, May 14th, 2010 at 7:30 pm. There will be wine, cheese, prayer and socializing!

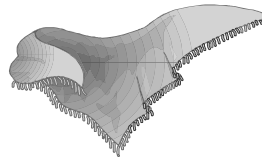

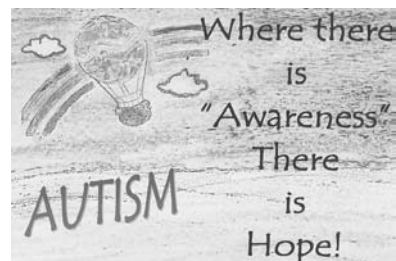
Prayer Shawl Ministry

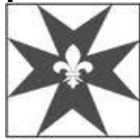
